Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order
Sandy Lane, Lower Failand, Oxhouse Lane & Failand Lane Failand North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2026
Date coming Into Force: 19th June 2026

Notice was hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by OPENREACH LIMITED to link existing BT Boxes, cabling and tree cutting works.. This order will become operative on the 19th June 2026 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 11 days in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule -

Phase 1: Oxhouse Lane from junction with Sandy Lane heading south to outside Failand House - 19-23 June 2026

Phase 2: Failand Lane from junction with Mill Lane to junction with Sandy Lane - 24-25 June 2026

Phase 3: Sandy Lane from junction with Failand Lane to Tanpit Lodge - 26-29 June 2026
